SUMMARY OF OFFENCE:

Count 1 – On November 17th, 2005 and November 18th, 2005, Sergeant vas absent from scheduled duty by utilizing casual family days as provided for in Article 16.06 of the Collective Agreement. The casual family days were used to fly to Halifax, Nova Scotia for a personal vacation, contrary to the purpose and intent of the entitlement.

Count 2 – On November 26th, 2005, Sergeant failed to comply with Peel Regional Police Directive I-B-722(F) in that he failed to protect a crime scene and safeguard any potential evidence.

Count 3 – On November 16th, 2005, Sergeant failed to comply with Peel Regional Police Directive I-B-134(F) requiring officers to complete all notes before reporting off duty. Sergeant failed to complete any notes at the time of the incident.

DISPOSITION:

Count 1 – Eight (8) hours to be worked at the discretion of the Divisional Commander.

Count 2 – Sixteen (16) hours to be worked at the discretion of the Divisional Commander.

Count 3 – Sixteen (16) hours to be worked at the discretion of the Divisional Commander.
