

**REPORT OF A DISCIPLINE OFFENCE TO
THE POLICE SERVICES BOARD**

OFFENCE(S): **Discreditable Conduct**, Contrary to Section 2.(1)(a)(xi) and **Neglect of Duty x 4**, Contrary to Section 2.(i)(c)(i), of the Code of Offences, *Police Services Act*

SUMMARY OF OFFENCE:

Count 1

Cst. █████ committed Discreditable Conduct on June 2nd, 2002. Constable █████ did so by compromising the identities and safety of other undercover officers. At the time officers were participants in a practical undercover training exercise being conducted by the Canadian Intelligence Services of Ontario. Cst. █████ allowed a known criminal to be present during a training exercise without the knowledge of the participants or instructors. This criminal was thereby able to not only observe the officers but witness the various investigative techniques used by them during their training.

Count 3

Constable █████ neglected his duties as they relate to his contact and involvement with a Confidential Informant. Constable █████ neglected his duties by:

- a) on numerous occasions he failed to complete proper duty notes detailing his contacts with a Confidential Informant and reward payments made to him.
- b) He failed to prepare and submit "Confidential Informant Follow-up forms for reward payments made to an informant, as required in accordance with Peel Regional Police directive I-B-709.
- c) He failed to receive proper authorization for a reward payment to a Confidential Informant as required in accordance with Peel Regional Police directive I-B-709.

DISPOSITION:

Count 1: Demoted from first class to second class for a period of six (6) months.

Count 3: Ten (10) eight (8) hour days to be worked at the discretion of his Divisional Commander.
